Successful Launch of World Peace Festival 20 -27 August, 2011

Berlin, 20 – 27 August, 2011, the First International Peace Festival was launched successfully with a two days International Peace Conference in which leading representatives from politics, military, civil society and business participated and provided new momentum for peace building worldwide. The idea to bring stakeholders from various different areas from around the world to address this urgent topic and challenge, proved to be an impressive success. This led to the development and presentation of new solutions for holistic, systemic and sustainable peace building for corporations across a multitude of different organizations, partners and countries.

There were large number of speakers taking part in the conference and prominent among them were Deepak Chopra, New York times bestselling author; Benjamin Kunbuor, Minister of the Interior, Ghana; Tim Cross, Major General, Senior British Commander in Baghdad; Mansoor Ijaz, terrorism expert, peace activist and philanthropist; Steve Killelea, founder of the Institute for Peace and the Global Peace Index; Jean Oelwang, CEO Virgin Unite; Chade-Meng Tan, Head of Google's School of Personal Growth; Clare Short, former UK Secretary of State
